BakerTriangle used Parex USA materials to install over one mile of EPS Shapes, 65,000 square feet of three coat stucco, 25,000 square feet of EIFS and over 12,000 square feet of direct applied ceilings and soffits.

A total of nine different textures, fifteen different colors, twelve antiquing gels incorporating four or five shades each for a total of over sixty color variations.

Only a site visit would help one appreciate the intricate details that went into this beautiful retail center. The EIFS shapes were coated with two coats of the Stucco D'Raffinato, giving them an amazing stone-like appearance. After sanding the stucco, Select Finish Antiquing Gels were used to achieve the Tuscan look that the architect was looking for. The accelerated schedule of this project was accomplished by fifty hour work weeks and talented craftsmen.
